**Brief Biography:**

Dr. Lori West is a clinician scientist and a world leader in pediatric heart transplantation and transplant immunobiology. She pioneered a strategy for increasing donor availability for infants by crossing the ABO barrier, a dramatic change in accepting clinical practice that had a major global impact on infant heart transplantation. Her study on the immune development of children after ABO incompatible transplantation led to the first demonstration of neonatal transplantation tolerance in humans. Dr. West is the Founding Director of the Canadian National Transplant Research Program, representing a coalition of 350+ research participants in 31 sites across Canada. She has served as Chair of CIHR Institute of Circulatory and Respiratory Health Advisory Board and ICRH Interim Scientific Director. She has also served as a member of CIHR's Governing Council.
